ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT (EIR) PROCESS OVERVIEW

Since 2017, Beach Cities Health District (BCHD) has conducted more than two years of meetings, study circles and a community open house with residents, business leaders and business owners; city leadership and staff; and finance, design and architecture experts, which has led BCHD to the next stage of the proposed Healthy Living Camus Master Plan: the Environmental Impact Report (EIR).

BCHD is preparing an EIR as the Lead Agency as required by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), with Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc., serving as EIR consultants for the project. The state-mandated EIR, which is expected to be completed in 2021, will inform the public and project decision-makers about significant environmental effects at the Redondo Beach site and identify possible ways to minimize or avoid those effects.
